Report on Anti-Ragging Activity Organized by Invertis University

Date: August 22, 2022

- 1. Introduction: Invertis University takes immense pride in fostering a safe and welcoming environment for all its students. As part of its commitment to providing a ragging-free campus, Professor K K Dubey, along with the support of the university administration, organized an Anti-Ragging Activity on August 22, 2022.  - 2. Objectives: The main objectives of the Anti-Ragging Activity were as follows:
