

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") is dated 30st January 2023.

BETWEEN

Sanchhaya Education Pvt. Ltd. Service Provider, where the Brand name is GeeksforGeeks, a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013, and having its principal place of business at 143, 9th Floor, Sovereign Corporate Tower, Greater Noida Expressway, Sector 136, Noida, Gautam (hereinafter referred to as "First Party")

AND

Invertis University (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party")

Referred to herein as "Parties" or "Party"

1. PROJECT AND SCOPE:

- a. The Parties intend for this MOU to provide the foundation and structure for any and all possibly anticipated binding agreements related to "Hackathon"
- b. The First Party represents that they are hosting an event where students shall meet and engage in a collaborative competition namely "Hackathon" which is hosted by the First Party whereby as per the mutually agreed terms the Second Party shall get a minimum of 50 teams and/or 200 students to register.
- c. The duration for getting the above mentioned registrations is between 1st to 18th February, 2023
- d. **Event Description:**
 - i. The First Phase of the Hackathon will be an online event for students which shall be conducted from **February to April** on the First Party's portal.
 - ii. Registrations shall begin and get closed during February 1st-18th, 2023.
 - iii. After building the solution, participants will submit their final project in **April, 2023** on the First Party's (GeeksforGeeks) portal and the First Party's team will assess the constenstants' performance according to the judging criteria. The decision made by the First Party shall be final and will not be changed.
 - iv. The students will work on the same project for the upcoming rounds (regional and national) of this Hackathon and will improve as per the feedback shared by the mentors in previous rounds.
 - v. Following review, the top 3 winning teams from Second party's institute will be announced in April.
 - vi. The top three qualifying teams will be required to report to the offline venue. If qualified, it is mandatory to attend the offline Hackathon.

2. CHANGES TO MEMORANDUM

- a. This Memorandum may be amended at any time by agreement between the Parties.
- b. Any changes to this Memorandum must be made in writing and signed by the Parties.

3. GENERAL OBLIGATIONS


- The Parties will act in good faith and will use their best endeavors to achieve the success of the Services decided herewith and to give effect to the terms of this Memorandum.
- The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree they will each respectively perform all acts and execute all documents as reasonably required in order to give effect to the terms of this Memorandum.
- Each Party agrees to cooperate in the spirit of mutual understanding and goodwill in order to develop the Parties' relationships with one another and in order to achieve the success of the services decided herewith.


4. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY:

- Second Party will have the following obligations and rights in relation to the Project:
 - The Second Party shall get a minimum of 50 and/or 200 students & teams to register from their college/university, where each team shall consist of 1 - 4 members. All participants must be from the same college/university.
 - The Second Party shall assign a faculty coordinator who can be contacted by the students for any queries. The Faculty coordinator can get in touch with the First Party directly.
 - For the duration of the Hackathon, The First Party will use the Second Party's name and logo for marketing purposes. The Second Party shall also be granted the right to use the First Party's logo and name while the competition is ongoing.
 - The Second Party may not partner with another organization for a similar purpose/competition during the duration of the event i.e. 'Hackathon.'
 - The Second Party understands and acknowledges that the Hackathon is contingent on sponsorship by a Third Party therefore it shall not hold the First Party liable for any loss, expense or any other such costs.
